

Subject: RE: SR 2001 Temporary Stockpile

Dear Mr. Roberts:

Thank you for the courtesy of informing us of this use of the I-84/SR 402 site. As I am sure you are aware, the residents of Blooming Grove have been forced to deal with a succession of negative events severely impacting our way of life over the last few years. As the I-84 NB/SR 402 site still remains open, residents continue to express their concern for the final disposition of that site.

There are several questions which will certainly arise upon release of the information concerning the temporary use of the site.

- 1.) Specifically, what is the material to be stored at the site? **Foreign Borrow for capping material.**
- 2.) Has this material been tested for content? **Yes, gradation.**
- 3.) Will test results be provided to Blooming Grove Township prior to shipping material to the township? **Attached (MB-2, not baghouse fines).**
- 4.) Where did the material originate? **Lackawanna County**
- 5.) What volume of material will be stored in Blooming Grove Township? **42,000 CY**
- 6.) Is this material for the exclusive use of the SR 2001 project in Lehman Township or will it include additional townships? **Exclusively for SR 2001**
- 7.) Specifically, what is the time frame that this material will be moved to, stored, completely removed from Blooming Grove Township and final restoration of the site completed? **To the site early next week. Removed and site restored by completion of the SR 2001 project.**
- 8.) Finally, the township would request during the final restoration of the site, it be graded in such a way that it could be used as an emergency landing zone for helicopters. Many residents of the township have expressed the belief that this use of the site would serve the public good and maintain the spirit of the site dedication for fallen Trooper, Bryon Dickson. Will be restored as closely as possible to original condition.
